Please note: We advise that you complete the packages as mentioned above (either via SMT or SGC, as specified) If you choose to access the training via Safeguarding (PWP) you will need to complete each lower level before your certificate will be released for the higher level, for example; to release your Safeguarding Children Level 3 certificate, you will need to complete all of the following modules:

- Safeguarding children Level 1
- Safeguarding children Level 2
- Safeguarding children Level 3
- External Resources
- Domestic Violence & Abuse

When you have found the course you need to complete, click on course title and click on the  button to start the training.

Once you have passed the training, your course completion will be recorded against your eLH record. You can print a certificate if you require one for your own records.

Only if you have entered '**RL403**' in '**Place of Work**' when you created your eLH account, will the RWT Training Team be able to record your course completion against you ESR training record.
