What is a CHSWG?

Children's Hearing Services Working Groups (CHSWGs) are based in all areas of the UK. CHSWGs give you, the parents and families of Deaf and Hearing Impaired Children, the opportunity to make a difference to the services provided for your children.

When?

CHSWG meets three times per year, but is active all year round in seeking the best technology and services for our children.

Where?

We usually meet at The Gem Centre, but sometimes at other venues throughout the city. We try to hold meetings somewhere convenient for all.

What happens at a CHSWG meeting?

At our friendly, BSL signed meetings we talk about how we are doing and what we can improve upon. We find out about new technology and services, and what's happening nationally. It is a great opportunity for the families who use our services to tell us what they like and what they think might be done differently.

Parents who come to CHSWG can contribute as much or as little as they like. Some people come along just to find out what's happening.

What if I can't come to the meetings?

We know that not everyone can come to the CHSWG meetings, and that's fine. You don't have to come to CHSWG meetings to get involved. Please tell us your comments or suggestions and we will bring them to the meeting on your behalf.

How do I join CHSWG?

Getting involved with CHSWG is very easy. Just tell your Audiologist or Teacher of the Deaf that you are interested. There are no joining fees.
