

Paediatric Stability Footwear

Orthotics



The prevention of infection is a major priority in all healthcare and everyone has a part to play.

- Wash your hands with soap and warm water and dry thoroughly. Use hand gel, if provided, in care facilities.
- If you have symptoms of diarrhoea and vomiting stay at home and do not visit relatives that are vulnerable in hospital or in residential care. You will spread the illness.
- Keep the environment clean and safe. Let's work together to keep it that way. Prevention is better than cure.

Your child has been prescribed with footwear to support their feet and help them to stand / walk.

Why is footwear prescribed?

Footwear may be prescribed for your child for a variety of reasons however it will normally be prescribed to increase stability or to reduce tiptoeing.

Insoles may be given to go inside the footwear, to support the foot position- in order to accommodate this you will need to take the existing inlay out of the footwear.

How many pairs of footwear will I get?

You will be prescribed one pair of footwear, which will be replaced as needed as they wear out or your child grows. The style you choose will need to be appropriate for both home and school

How long will my child have to wear stability footwear for?

At each review appointment your orthotist will assess to see whether stability footwear is still required- some children may only need one issue, whilst others may need to wear stability boots for a longer period of time.

How to check the size of footwear?

Take the insole out of the footwear and check this against your child's foot, if there is less than 1cm from the child's biggest toe and the end of the insole please contact the orthotics department for a review.

Do I need to check my child's feet?

You should do the following on a daily basis:

Inspect all aspects of your child's foot for red marks, abrasions, bruising or wounds.

If your child is experiencing discomfort or the skin is markedly red or broken please contact the orthotics department immediately for advice.

Always check the footwear for stones or debris before putting them on

Do I need to build up tolerance to my footwear?

To build up the use of your child's footwear follow the advice in the table below. You may be advised to wear the footwear full time, or only for certain tasks, please follow the advice of the orthotist.

When will your child's footwear be reviewed?

Your child will normally be reviewed every 6 months, however if you have any concerns or feel that your child has outgrown their footwear please contact the orthotics department for review.
